- Increase the weighted percent of students in grades 3rd through 5th scoring at the Developing Learner or above on the 2023 Georgia Milestones ELA by 5%.
- Increase the weighted percent of students in grades 3rd through 5th scoring at the Developing Learner or above on the 2023 Georgia Milestones Math by 5%.
- For the 2023-2024 school year, implement PBIS with fidelity to maintain emerging status or higher by the end of May 2024.
- *Increase Family and Parent engagement by 5% for the 2023-2024 school year.*

Flat Shoals Elementary teachers will:

- Provide families with a monthly newsletter that features games and activities that families can play to review vocabulary words being covered in class.
- Provide timely feedback to parents about concerns and questions.
- Set up conferences and encourage student-led conferences.
- Provide meaningful homework assignments that reinforce lessons taught.

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Read the class newsletters and play the word games provided for vocabulary words.
- Ensure the students are attending school regularly, on time, and ready to learn.
- Participate in virtual school meetings, virtual parent workshops, and parent teacher conferences.
- Communicate with the school about their children's specific academic performance and physical needs.
- Sign and return the children's agenda or daily folder as scheduled by their classroom teacher.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

Students will:

- Bring home the class newsletter featuring vocabulary word games and play these games at home with their families to gain practice using the vocabulary words.
- Exhibit Mustang behavior every day at school.
- Attend school regularly.
- Come to school committed to doing their best every day.
- Believe they can and will learn.
- Sign and return the child's agenda or daily folder every day.
- Make an effort to complete their homework assignment every night.
